








#### RENEWABLE ENERGY DEVELOPMENT – PRIORITY TERRITORY




- After thorough research
   priority territory for renewable
   energy development in the
   Baltic Sea was announced;
- The territory of
   620 sq.km with a preliminary capacity of 3,35 GW;
- Was adopted by the Government



#### RENEWABLE ENERGY DEVELOPMENT – DEVELOPMENT IN STAGES



- Spatial planning was carried out for the whole territory;
- Two plots were dedicated for offshore wind development;
- The plots were confirmed by the Government



#### **OFFSHORE WIND DEVELOPMENT: TENDERS**



**700 MW** 1st tender (*Curonian Nord*)— "green field" format with a spatial plan in place. Tender procedures ended in July, 2023. The winner got permit for building and exploitation in February, 2024. Expected commission – 2030, onshore connection.

#### **700 MW**



**2nd tender** – preparatory works done. Tender procedures were announced void in April, 2024 due to one participant.

The second attempt after amends to the conditions is officially set for November 18<sup>th</sup>.

Expected commission – 2030, onshore connection.



#### **OFFSHORE WIND DEVELOPMENT: TENDER'S COMING SOON**



#### **Preparatory works in place:**

- ✓ Spatial planning;
- ✓ Geophysical and geotechnical seabed surveys;
- ✓ One-year metocean data (9-10 m/s);
- ✓ Two-year environmental impact assessment (birds, bats, sea mammals);
- ✓ Connection corridor infrastructure development plan.


#### **Tender procedures:**

- Prolonged term for proposal submission 120 c. d.;
- Evaluation of the documents max 90 c. d.;
- CfD or development fee;
- First development fee at least EUR 5 mln.;
- Indexed CfD depending on inflation rate (anually);
- Permit to use the territory for 41 years.

#### Developer:

- Support of coastal communities;
- Implementation of GHG reduction;
- No threat to national security interests
